## All important events from its formation until today.

1872	Gottfried Schenker founds Schenker & Co in Vienna / Austria.	1999	Takeover of BTL AB. Schenker Australia appointed Official Freight Forwarder of the Sydney Olympics.
1873 - 74	First consolidated rail consignment from Paris/France to Vienna/Austria. Branch offices established in Budapest/Hungary, Bucharest/Romania and Prague/Czech Republic.	2000	Opening of the integrated Logistics Center in Rotterdam/Netherlands. Schenker nominated for the Salt Lake City 2002 - Olympic Winter games. Schenker and Deutsche Bahn established Railog JV for rail related logistics services.
1922	First air freight shipments in Germany.	2002	Schenker celebrates its 130 <sup>th</sup> birthday. Deutsche Bahn takes over majority of Stinnes.
1931	Schenker is acquired by the German Railways. First ocean freight shipments.	2003	Official supplier to the IOC for freight forwarding and customs clearance services for the Olympic Games in Athens 2004, Turin 2006, Beijing 2008.
1947	Subsidiary established in the US, internationalization and air freight are pursued on a large scale.	<b>2004</b>	<b>Schenker opens the 3<sup>rd</sup> Branch in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in Dammam as a Project Support – Branch Office for the SAFCO 4 / Uhde - Ammonia plant project in Al Jubail.</b> <b>Project volume : 150.000 F/tons</b>
1972	Schenker becomes the official freight forwarder for Munich Olympics. Coinage of JETcargo, SEAcargo, and EUROcargo as trade marks for bulk transportation by air, ocean and road.	2006	Integration of BAX Global strengthens Schenker's presence in the important markets around the globe.
<b>1975</b>	<b>Schenker opened the 1<sup>st</sup> Branch in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in Jeddah as a Project Support - Branch Office for the construction of Jeddah International airport.</b> <b>Project volume : 820.000 F/tons.</b>	<b>2006</b>	<b>Schenker Saudi Arabia appointed as Freight Forwarder for Saudi Youth Welfare Organization during the FIFA world cup in Germany.</b> <b>Schenker starts own ocean freight consolidation service (LCL) from Germany, Italy and the Netherlands to Jeddah.</b>
<b>1988</b>	<b>Schenker opens the 2<sup>nd</sup> Branch in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in Riyadh.</b>	<b>2007</b>	<b>Schenker starts own ocean freight consolidation service (LCL) from Germany, to Dammam.</b> <b>Schenker expands own ocean freight consolidation service (LCL) to Jeddah and adds a service from the USA.</b> <b>Schenker opens 1<sup>st</sup> own dedicated CFS in Jeddah – Freezone / JBRZ.</b>
1991	Stinnes AG acquires a majority stake in Schenker from the German railway company – Deutsche Bundesbahn - and divides the business into Schenker International (air and ocean freight) and Schenker Eurocargo (European land transport).	<b>2008</b>	<b>Appointed freight forwarder for Saudi Olympic Committee.</b> <b>Establishment of Schenker Saudi Arabia LLC as 100 % Schenker owned foreign investment company.</b>
		<b>2009</b>	<b>Opens 1<sup>st</sup> Sales Office in Al Jubail ( Eastern Province).</b> <b>SCHENKER opens 2<sup>nd</sup> owned dedicated CFS in Dammam – Freezone /DBRZ.</b>
